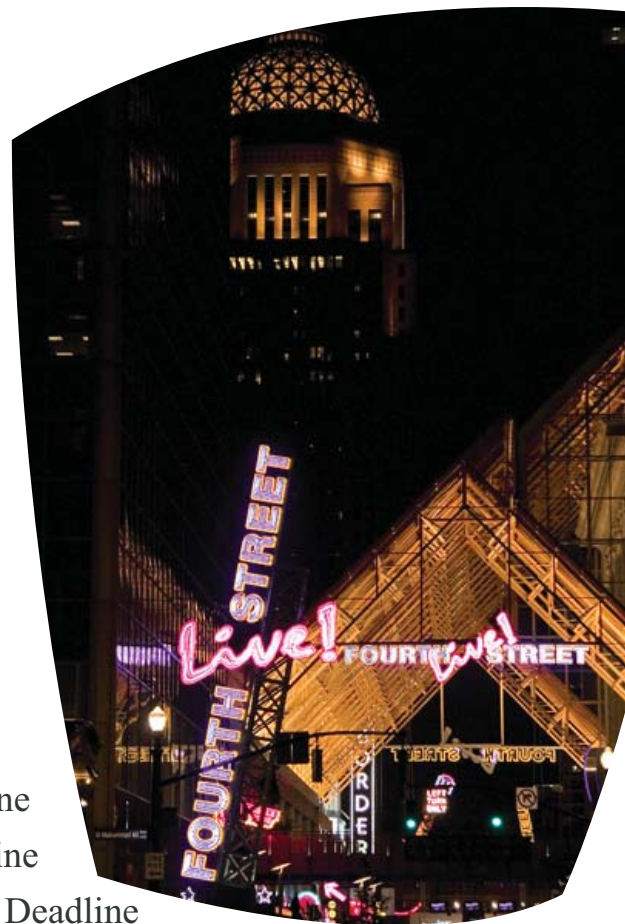

Susan R. Komives is Professor of College Student Affairs at the University of Maryland. She is president of the Council for the Advancement of Standards in Higher Education and a former President of the American College Personnel Association. She served as Vice President of two colleges and is the author of a dozen books or monographs including *Student Services and Exploring Leadership*. A recipient of both the ACPA and NASPA outstanding scholarship awards, her research includes an international Multi-institutional Study of Leadership involving 104 campuses and over 115,000 responders in Spring 2006.

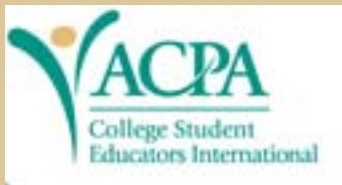
